The objective of the role of Data Analyst is to deep dive into our data, helping to maintain, understand and report on it. You will use data to solve tough business problems, provide insights and in so doing, enable your colleagues to track progress and make decisions. This role is about solving problems with fit-forpurpose data and analytics techniques.

### THE TECHNICAL CHALLENGE
